Duties and Responsibilities

1. Evaluate patients' medical condition and clinical history to determine the most suitable radiographic technique for diagnosis.
2. Perform diagnostic imaging examinations including **X-rays, ultrasound, computed tomography (CT), magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), and mammography** as required.
3. Produce high-quality radiographic images for accurate diagnosis of medical conditions.

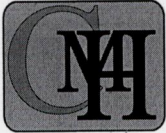

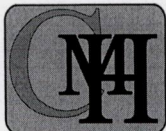

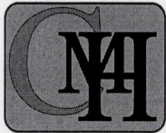
